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Axis360 services for Alexandria Installation Guide

With the Axis360 Extras option activated, Alexandria can provide Patron Authentication and Verification services for Axis360. Before allowing patrons to access and borrow Axis360 items, their status and credentials will be validated with Alexandria. If your patron is authorized and in good standing, they will be permitted to use Axis360 resources. If not, they will be denied access to these resources until they can correct the discrepancies with the librarian.

To enable Axis360 services for Alexandria

For Alexandria and Axis360 to be able to communicate, some key information must be provided:

- 1) The Alexandria server IP Address or Domain Name, Web Port, and Serial Number. Your Alexandria server must be publicly accessible outside of your site or district firewall. Provide this information to Axis360 so they can configure your account. Note: Axis360 will use the Serial Number in the SIP2 Login Message (93 CP).
- 2) Axis360 Code. This is similar to a password just for Axis360; Axis360 must configure your account to use it in order to communicate with Alexandria. You create this code. After selecting one and entering it into the Axis360 Code field in preferences, provide it to your account representative at Axis360. Note: Axis360 will use this code in the SIP2 Login Message (93 CO).

Enable Axis 360

For axis 360 to work with Alexandria, an axis 360 Code is required for authentication. The default code was configured and provided when your axis 360 account was set up. If your axis 360 Code needs to be changed for any reason, it must be communicated to axis 360 Technical Support so that your account can be properly reconfigured and updated.

Enable checksum error handling

Checksum error handling is enabled by default. This should only be disabled under the direction of Technical Support.
