Perma-eHub services for Alexandria Installation Guide

With the Perma-eHub Extras option activated, Alexandria can provide Patron Authentication and Verification services for Perma-eHub. Before allowing patrons to access and borrow Perma-eHub items, their status and credentials will be validated with Alexandria. If your patron is authorized and in good standing, they will be permitted to use Perma-eHub resources. If not, they will be denied access to these resources until they can correct the discrepancies with the librarian.

To enable Perma-eHub services for Alexandria

For Alexandria and Perma-eHub to be able to communicate, some key information must be provided:

- 1) The Alexandria server IP Address or Domain Name, Web Port, and Serial Number. Your Alexandria server must be publicly accessible outside of your site or district firewall. Provide this information to Perma-Bound so they can configure your account. Note: Perma-eHub will use the Serial Number in the SIP2 Login Message (93 CP).
- 2) Perma-eHub Code. This is similar to a password just for Perma-eHub; Perma-eHub must configure your account to use it in order to communicate with Alexandria. You create this code. After selecting one and entering it into the Perma-eHub Code field in preferences, provide it to your account representative at Perma-Bound. Note: Perma-eHub will use this code in the SIP2 Login Message (93 CO).
