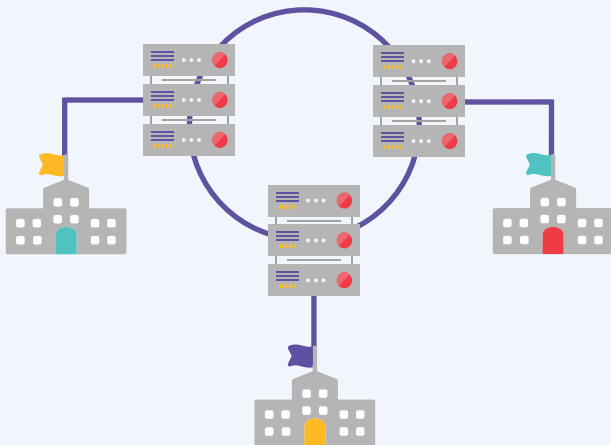


DISTRIBUTED VS. CENTRAL CATALOGS

DISTRIBUTED CATALOG

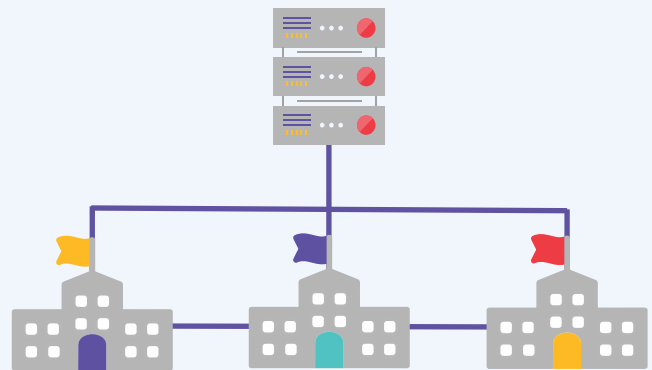


Alexandria's Distributed Catalog is for single sites, or a district that would like their schools to maintain their own collections with greater autonomy.

Alexandria's Centralized Catalog is for a District that wants to consolidate multiple libraries into one database to share one catalog.

- Central office will run all archives and utilities
