Expired Patrons

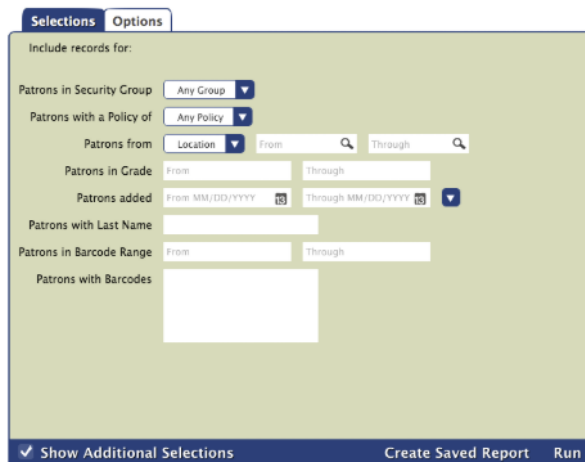
 This report will only generate results when **Preferences > Patrons > Patron Rules > Disable Card Expiration Dates** is unchecked.

The *Expired Patrons* report creates a list of patrons with expired library cards. Card expiration dates can be viewed or edited on the **Personal Info** tab of **Patrons Management**. Set the number of days patrons' cards are active using [patron policies](#).

Run this report regularly to see which patrons need to be renewed or removed.

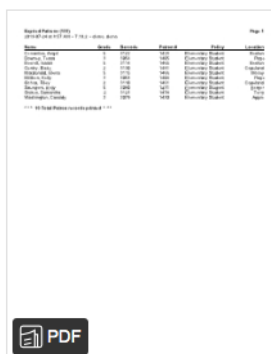

That's right. For *every single* report, you can now look up what it does, read about situations in which you might use it, and view PDF examples of each format.

This documentation is organized exactly like the reports section in Alexandria, with the same categories and subcategories. Start on the [Complete Reports List](#) page and click on a category icon or type the specific report's name in the search bar. Once you're on a subcategory page, click on the report's name to expand that section.

For example...

If I were trying to find the *Patron Balance* report, I would click on the **Circulation** category icon, then the **Charges and Information** subcategory, and then **Patron Balance**. Or, if I didn't know which category icon to click on, I would simply type "Patron Balance report" in that page's little search bar and click on the subcategory that pops up in the results. Voilà!
