

Operator Alert

The Operator Alert utility allows you to enter a 100 character message that will display to the Operator in a popup window when the patron attempts to sign in or out through Attended Kiosk. The alert message can be accessed and customized by going to [People Management > Access](#).

If the Patron is unauthorized for the Classification they are attempting to sign into, they will receive the following message:
