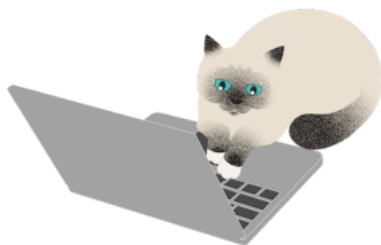


# Searching by Subject
