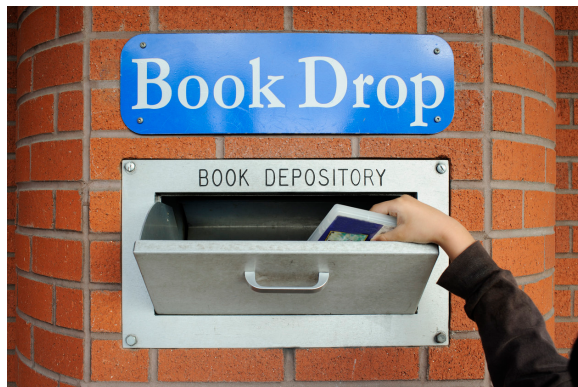


Get your books back—send emails!

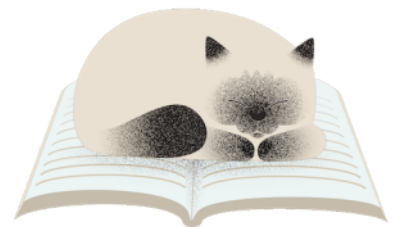
